Overseas Missions

African enterprise Ministry Teams

African Enterprise is a Christian interdenominational, interracial ministry of evangelism, reconciliation, leadership training, relief and development. AE works with leaders in the African church to mobilize their congregations in outreach to Africa's cities.

Chuck & Heather Stephens

A tent-making couple based in South Africa, Heather is in education and Chuck is in relief and development. They also operate the Centre for Learning, a growing retreat and conference centre in the Lowveld of South Africa.

Tim & Peti Webster (SAMS)

The South American Missionary Society in Canada is a volunteer mission society of the Anglican Church. It has two purposes: to locate and assist those whom God is calling to mission service in Latin America and to expand mission education within the Anglican Church of Canada. The Webster's are doing work in Santiago, Chile.

Bob & Madeline Blanchard (TEAM)

The Evangelical Alliance Mission is an interdenominational missionary organization with 750 missionaries serving in regions of five continents. TEAM's purpose is to help churches send missionaries to establish reproducing churches among the nations to the glory of God. Bob also serves with TEAM's Timothy Network as a function of the Member Care programs.

Winnipeg Missions

Crisis Pregnancy Centre

The Crisis Pregnancy Centre is a division of the Family Support Centre of Winnipeg, Inc. which is a not-for-profit Christian ministry dedicated to the further and preservation of all life—the already born and the relatively soon-to-be born.

Hope Centre Health Care

A charitable organization which is designed to be a place for people to find hope for spiritual, emotional, physical and social healing, carrying out a program of medical and dental services, counseling, educational and community development in a Christian context.

House of Hesus

A non-profit, non-denominational Christian organization established in response to the needs of people living with HIV.

Inter-Varsity

Pioneer Camp is a ministry to children and youth, committed to welcoming, serving and teaching children in the name of Jesus. Pioneer is also a place of leadership development and training for Christian youth.

New Direction for Life

A pro-people organization offering Christian support to men and women choosing to leave homosexuality, and equipping the church to minister effectively and compassionately.



UGM Family Life Centre

Offers adult education and other support programs inner-city adults. Along with literacy, high school and ESL (English as a second language), Christian devotionals and speakers are a part of the classroom experience with a "personal touch".

Winnipeg Harvest

Every month, 15,587 households receive food from Winnipeg Harvest. Their mission is to collect and distribute food to feed those in our community who struggle to feed themselves and their families, and to maximize public awareness of hunger.
