2019 Financial Update

The parish is very thankful and was so blessed as parishioners responded to our financial needs in the final month of 2019. Giving towards general revenues exceeded \$85,000 for December allowing full year revenue to slightly exceed the \$420,650 budgeted revenue. Parish expenses were tightly controlled and ended slightly under budget for the year. Subject to any final adjustments the Parish ended the 2019 year with a General Fund surplus of just over \$3,600 which was better than budget.

Parishioner contributions to the Boiler Replacement/ Capital Fund during December were over \$19,000, bringing our total permanent funding for the large capital project to just over \$88,500 versus the \$104,000 cost. The shortfall in the Capital Fund of \$15,500 will be carried over into our 2020 budget needs.
