From Sunday, April 19 to the Day of Pentecost on May 31, we will be teaching on the Gifts of the Holy Spirit. This in keeping with our focus this year on our Real God; the Holy Spirit. We begin this Sunday with, 'The Gift of the Holy Spirit,' then move onto: The Revelation Gifts - wisdom, knowledge and discernment; The Power Gifts - faith, healing and working of miracles; The Vocal Gifts - tongues, interpretation & prophecy; Gifts for Service; Gifts for Unity; and finishing with the Gift of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost - using our Gifts. A key passage for the series will be 1 Corinthians 12: 4-11 but there will also be different readings for each Sunday. Please pray, prepare and partake!
