## REAL Mission - Week 3. Mission without Compromise

## Readings

Luke 19: 11-27; Philippians 1: 12-30; & Ezekiel 33: 1-9

Begin by Worshipping God in prayer with Psalm 27: 7-14

Read the Luke and Philippians passages. How do people respond to the Gospel message, can you think of other Scriptures that describe this response? How do these reactions make you feel?
Speak Up Ezekiel 33: 1-9, Acts 1: 8  How does the charge given to Ezekiel connect to the charge given to us by Christ to be His witnesses? What link do you see with our previous thoughts on being Salt and Light?

Considering our Scriptures we identified how we can step out in faith in Mission based on our relationship with God, by using the Gifts that He has given us and as a Church. How do you believe we

should step out, how can the Church equip you?

What suggestions could you bring to Café Church and our planning in in the fall?
Give All Phil. 1: 12-30  On Sunday we agreed that this is a tough and serious mission.  Real also Luke 10: 1-17 and draw out the importance of this mission?
What encouragement and strength do we find in Luke 10: 17, Phil 1: 19, Hebrews 12: 2-3 and how does Paul say we should respond in Phil. 1: 27-30
